

## **Maine Township Aquatics Participant Waiver and Release of Liability**

As the legal parent or guardian of the registered participant, I hereby give consent for him/her to participate in the Maine Township Aquatics swim program located in the Maine East High School Aquatics facility. I, or any guardian, in relation to the participant assumes responsibility for the health and well-being of the swimmer and agree to the following terms under the **Participant Waiver and Release of Liability** agreement:

1. We, Maine Township Aquatics, reserve the right to make changes to the schedule. All parents will be notified upon these changes.
2. I warrant that the participant, needless of age, is under good health and condition with the full capacity to partake in the swim lesson activities.
3. I acknowledge that as the guardian of the swimmer, I assume all risks associated with the nature of the activity including the following injuries (but are not limited to): back pains, soreness, cuts, bruises, accidents involving drowning or choking of water, neck pains, or slipping incidents.
4. The supervisors, directors, and instructors have full consent to actively teach the participant how to swim, dive, and any other aquatic related activities regardless of age.
5. All swimmers, including guardians, will follow all given policies and regulations.
6. All swimmers will follow the instructor orders. If failure to comply, potential injuries and hazardous conditions may occur. Swimmers will be asked to leave if they are not fully compliant with the instructor or cause a disturbance harmful to others. No refund or credit awarded.
7. I will be sure to notify staff members of the aquatics program regarding any medical conditions that the participant may have, or result from.
8. I agree to the processing and insurance fees that result under the conditions of enrollment in the program.
9. Parents are required to check the website and emails weekly for updates.
10. If there are any issues, comments, or concerns, please contact us immediately.
11. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
12. Parents are advised to designate a meeting area with their children after lessons.
13. Swimmers are solely responsible for bringing the required necessities to lessons: swim suits, goggles, caps, etc. Equipment may be purchased on deck.
14. I am above the age of 18 years old.
15. I give full consent for my child's picture to be taken and used appropriately as a reference on the webpage.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and agreed to all terms. I give full consent for the child noted to participate in all aquatic related activities under instructor and supervisor supervision. I understand that should I not comply with these rules can result in exclusion of swim lessons for the child. Any concerns that I may have will be directed and dealt upon with a supervisor.
